College Signings by Reinhardt and Broward to be Captured May 22

(FAIRBURN, GA – May 21, 2019) Arlington Christian School's (ACS) class of 2019 is set to do just what eagles do: soar! The amazing class of 22 seniors has a very promising future ahead of them, both individually and collectively. Kefa, recipient of Head of School award, will be attending Broward on an athletic scholarship.

The class, which was essentially dominated by males (16 boys and 6 girls) reflects 95% of the alumni heading to college (19) or an institution of higher learning (2). One scholar will be beginning an entrepreneurship venture. Also, 60% graduated as members of Arlington's Chapter of the National Honor Society (NHS), and 18% graduated as Honor graduates with averages of 3.5 or better. The school's Salutatorian, **Dean Walston**, will be attending Fisk University on an academic scholarship.
